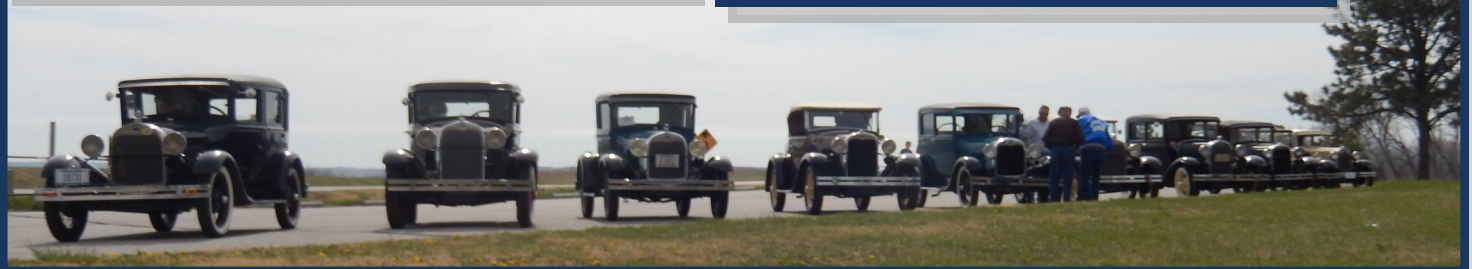
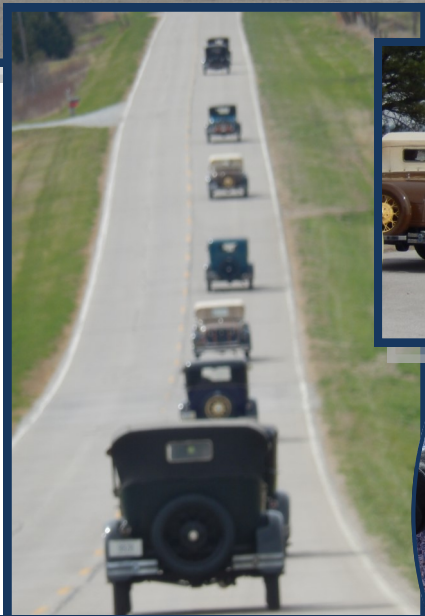
FIRST TOUR OF THE YEAR - AROUND BRANCHED OAK LAKE
