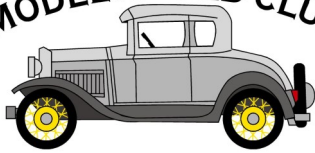

May 3, 2014 Cornhusker Model A Club Meeting Minutes

The May 3, 2014 Cornhusker Model A Ford Club (CMAFC) monthly meeting at Fourth Presbyterian Church 52nd and Francis, Lincoln was called to order by President Margaret Mays at 7:30 p.m. with 36 members present. Best wishes were extended to those celebrating birthdays and anniversaries. Judy Callaway indicated her birthday on May 17 had not been listed in the newsletter. Joan Taylor made a motion seconded by Linda Buckley that the minutes of the April 2014 meeting be approved as distributed via email and printed newsletters. Motion passed.

Treasurer's Report Treasurer Jenn Elliot presented the report as follows:

Starting Checking Balance: \$3,129.65

Ending Checking Balance: \$3,206.99

Starting Savings Balance: \$3,457.27

Ending Savings Balance: \$3,457.38 (\$.11 interest).

\$552.00 had been received as income for newsletter ads.

\$25.00 needed to be refunded so actual income was \$527.50.

Expenses included \$6.36 for newsletter and \$265.60 for the April breakfast. Jenn also mentioned that if anyone wanted a name badge there is a price break for 10 or more and we have nine requested.

Bills Submitted

The following bills were submitted: Margaret Mays - \$11.27 for newsletter and Janet Beauvais - \$178.20 for a 3 year contract with our website host, Bluehost. (Payment cheaper when paying for 3 years and refund available if cancel contract) Donna Best moved approval of payment of bills as presented. The motion was seconded by Jim Cook and passed.

Committee Reports

Activities: Sharon Griess indicated that Kathy Cook, Bernice Jeffries and Janet Beauvais have agreed to bring treats in June.

New Business:

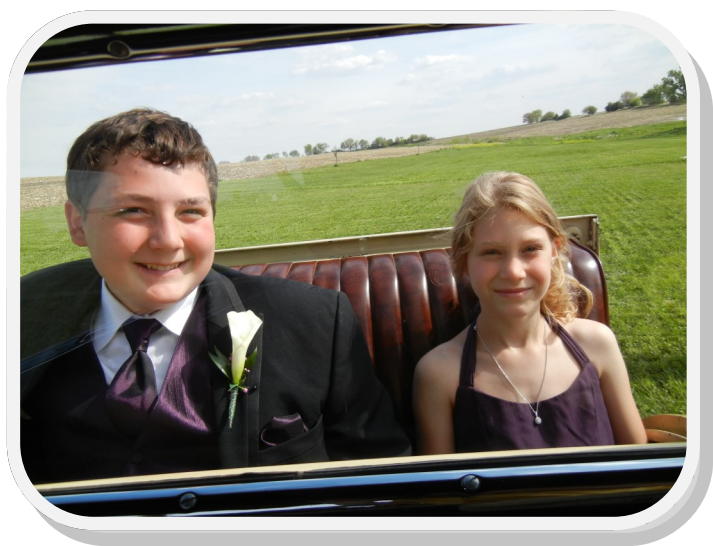
Lumir Vajgrt reported. that Czech Days would be held at the PlaMor on Sunday, May 4 and there would also be a community music event on May 12.
