HOW TO CHECK CONDENSER FOR GOOD SPARK.

- 1. Remove distributor cap, body and rotor.
- 2. Close points.
- 3. Turn on ignition switch.
- 4. Place high tension wire (from coil center) to one inch from good ground on engine.
- 5. Open points with screw driver, then close. (You should have a large spark with straight line). Also blue tinge.

With a bad condenser, you will still have jump but with low spark


