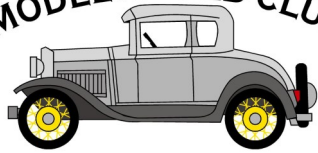

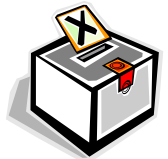

tech tip ●●●●

HOW TO CHECK CONDENSER FOR GOOD SPARK.

1. Remove distributor cap, body and rotor.
2. Close points.
3. Turn on ignition switch.
4. Place high tension wire (from coil center) to one inch from good ground on engine.
5. Open points with screw driver, then close. (You should have a large spark with straight line). Also blue tinge.

***With a bad condenser,
you will still have jump but with low spark***
