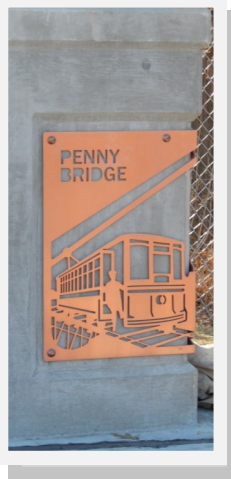
New Members

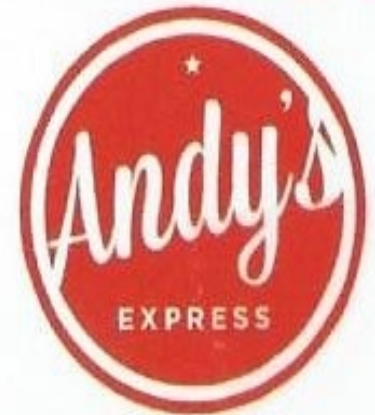
