On March 3rd, 1969, the Club paid \$19.95 to the Dailey Reporter for printers fee for Incorporation. Also, \$7.55 was paid to Walt Jackman for Incorporation expenses at the State House and Court House. The Club made a profit on food sales at the Louisville Swap Meet of \$2.62

EARLY HISTORY OF THE CORNHUSKER MODEL A FORD CLUB

The Cornhusker Chapter of the Model A Ford Club of America was organized in late 1959, and the club's charter was issued by MAFCA on June 19 of 1960.

The original 5 members were: Donald "Tony" Tonniges (also the first President), Dr. Milton B. Gates (the second President), Walter Jackman, Harold "Lucy" Heil, and Russell Cooper.

The Articles of Incorporation were filed with the NE Secretary of State on February 16, 1962.

The first club tour was on May 22, 1960, with 6 Model A's touring in Lincoln and to Crete. In September of that year, 8 A's went to Omaha for an overnight including a campfire. By November, 11 Model A's made another trip to Omaha to visit Boys Town.

The first swap meet was held on April 23, 24, 1961 in Louisville, NE. The swap meet moved to the State Fair Grounds in either 1963 or 1964.

The first meetings were held in a garage and then moved to the old telephone building on south 19th St, then to Robert's party room, and later to the Cengas bldg., various loan companies, and the Antelope Park picnic house.

The first edition of the club newsletter, Chatter and Clatter, was issued in 1967 by Dorothy Hornung and Sue Brown.
That paper was run off on a hand operated ink printer at the office of the Portsche Company where Sue Brown worked.

In 1960/1961 there were 11 members. By 1965 there were 45 members. By 1975, the membership increased to 60 and by 1990 had swelled to 82.

Of our current members:

The one to first join the club was Myron Smith who joined with his parents in 1968. Lumir Vajgrt also joined later that year. Those who have maintained the longest continuous memberships are Ray Hogrefe, who joined in 1976 and Ed and Joan Taylor who joined in 1978.


