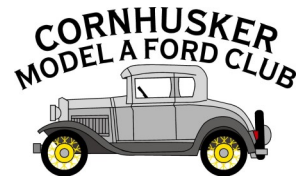

At the end of each day the cars were returned to their homes only to be taken out the following morning to repeat the process.
